

# LAMINGTON NATIONAL CLASSIC

9-10 OCTOBER 1993

The event which must surely be the most scenic on the running calendar saw a total of 65 runners make the journey at least in one direction this year. The conditions were once again ideal.

With the earlier start times on each day, few other park users were encountered and all concerned had more time for race post-mortems. A light luncheon was also arranged on Saturday which was subsidised from the entry fee. O'Reilly's Guest House also supplied much appreciated water and oranges after the run.

A number of well-credentialled runners new to the event lined up this year and, unfortunately, a few of them could not cope with the terrain. Not all runners are suited to the event.

It was also good to see two competitors who hail from locations distant from the Lamington National Park. Chris Louth, a member of the Cairns Road Runners spent a week in the location after the event and the winner on Saturday, Peter Moore hails from the North Canberra club. Peter has recently moved to Brisbane, already making his mark here winning a few fun runs and the Pyramid Mountain race at Gordonvale.

Although a few difficulties were encountered in the lead up to the event and the hastily re-arranged starting procedure, all runners managed to depart without too much difficulty. Unfortunately a few runners elected to take the slower tourist route around Daves Creek.

Following a most enjoyable smorgasbord BBQ arranged by the guest house, presentations were made during the evening by Mr Peter O'Reilly, manager of O'Reilly's Guest House to Peter Moore (1:31:02) and Nicole Carroll (2:24:23) being the fastest male and female for the forward journey.

Sunday morning saw 36 runners/walkers enter the rainforest from O'Reilly's at various times from 7:30am. Again the earlier start time allowed more time for runners to shower, relax and mull over the run before presentations were made by the manager of Binna Burra Lodge, Mr James Leighton. The winning duo was Don Wallace (1:29:07) and, for the second year, Judy Briscoe (1:55:50).

The combined event was won by Ashgrove pair Don Wallace and Nicole Carroll. Don won the event for the third time and was awarded the perpetual trophy, this time permanently.

*The teams event was again won by Ashgrove who finished 1st, 2nd, and 4th overall. We need to reconsider this section of the event in future years, as to whether it should continue, and if so the make-up of teams.*

*Due to the World Masters Games being held in early October 1994, it may be necessary to schedule the event a week later. I am also looking into the possibility of advertising the event with the Games organisation as a post-Games event.*

*We will probably make other changes to the event next year, such as an earlier start time of 8:30/9:00am as well as changing the direction of the run. However, the latter change will depend on suitable accommodation and function venue.*

*Thanks once again must go to Des Law for marking the track. However, for some, his efforts were in vain as the Daves Creek circuit claimed a number of victims again!*

*Elaine Robertson was thrilled with her third placing overall. She epitomises the reason why we like to support the event - the run is a participation event, rather than a win-at-all-costs race.*
